Messianic Chanukah Blessings

The first two are recited every night during the candle lighting ceremony.

The third is a blessing of joy and is traditionally recited at the beginning of all festivals. The third blessing is only recited on the first night.

1. Baruch ata Ad-nai, El-heinu melech ha'olam Asher Kidashanu Al Y'Day Emuna B'Yeshua HaMashiach Or Ha-Olam Uv-veesh-mo Mad-lick- keem Ha-nair Shel Chanukah.

Blessed are You, L-rd our G-d, King of the Universe, Who has sanctified us through faith in Yeshua, the Messiah, the Light of the World. And it is in His Name we kindle the Chanukah lights.

2. Baruch ata Ad-nai, El-heinu melech ha'olam she'asa nisim la'avoteinu b'yamim ha'heym b'zman hazeh.

Blessed are you, L-rd our G-d, King of the universe, who performed miracles for our ancestors, in those days, in this season.

3. Baruch ata Ad-nai, El-heinu melech ha'olam Shehecheeyanoo, v'keey'mano V'heegeeyanoo lazman hazeh.

Blessed are you, L-rd our G-d, King of the universe, for giving us life, for sustaining us, and for helping us to reach this moment.
